Dear Black Belts and Karate students,

Hello, my name is Sensei Dennis Toomey and I have been teaching in the Fairborn and Huber Heights area since 1987. I would like to personally invite you and your students to an interclub karate tournament on **Saturday, April 11, 2009, at Dayton Academy of Gymnastics in Huber Heights, Ohio at 5051 Nebraska Avenue.** I know how tough times are, and I would like to offer a low cost tournament as a way of saying thank you to all our students and parents for their dedication to Karate. **The entry fee will be only \$20 and the parent spectator fee will be only \$1.00.**

**Registration will start at 11:00 and the tournament will start at 12:15.** This will be a Kyu grade tournament, meaning there will be no black belt competition, only brown belt and under. However we are offering black belt demonstrations that will take place at the beginning of the tournament. The divisions (weapons, forms, and fighting), will be made the day of the tournament depending on how many competitors there are in each age group. Tentatively, we hope to have a jujitsu division where the students can show off their standing, throwing, and grappling skills. In the jujitsu division, any student 12 and up would be able to compete based on their weight, not their rank. There will be 2 one minute rounds and points will be scored for: punches and kicks standing (1 pt.), takedowns or throws (2pts), reversals and good techniques from the ground (1pt), and tap-outs (4pts). The student with the most points at the end of two rounds wins. There will be awards for **all places**, in all divisions, including 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place medals.

### **ATTENTION BLACK BELTS**

I need black belt volunteers to do a short demonstration (1-5 minutes) at the beginning of the tournament. This would be a no fee demonstration of your choice. It could be a kata, a self-defense demo, a breaking demonstration, or even a synchronized form with some of your students. **Every black belt who performs will get a special award.** Please volunteer and let's show the parents what the black belts can do!
